This funding will be used to

- Enable 75% of the Prep – Year 2 of eligible students to achieve a 'C' standard or above in English in 2022.
- Enable 30% of the Prep – Year 2 of eligible students to achieve a 'B' standard or above in English in 2022.

Our initiatives include

- Ensure the early diagnosis and support of students starting school with speech-language deficits.
- Provide other early learning support to 'at risk' students.
- Provide support to facilitate the whole school guided reading program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employ additional Speech Language Pathologist time to identify needs; support teachers; and develop and implement programs for Prep students.	\$10 500
• Provide additional Learning Support time.	\$8 653
• Employ support staff to support the teaching of reading in the Australia Curriculum.	\$33 700
