Coominya State School will receive

\$64,698*

This funding will be used to

- increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English in Prep – Year 3 from 59% in 2018 to 75% in 2019.
- increase the percentage of Year 3 students achieving above National Minimum Standard in Writing from 90.1% in 2018 to 100% in 2019.
- increase the percentage of Year 5 students achieving above National Minimum Standard in Writing from 70% in 2018 to 100% in 2019.

Our initiatives include

- providing targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum in the teaching of writing.
- ensuring early diagnosis and intervention for students starting school with speech-language deficits.
- providing support to facilitate whole school guided reading program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by
